

Rationale

Spliceteq South Communications Ltd (Hereinafter in this document referred to as the Company) is committed to ensuring, so far as is reasonably practicable through best practice, the health, safety and welfare of its employees and others who may be affected by matters within its control.

To this end the Company, in compliance with its duties under the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012, has produced this Asbestos Management Policy which shall apply to all potential site locations where asbestos may be present.

Objectives

- Prevent exposure to the hazards associated with asbestos containing materials (ACMs)
- Identify the location of ACMs; the type where reasonably practicable, the amount and its condition
- Provide and maintain an Asbestos Register which records those locations and the condition of the ACMs
- Assess the risk from ACMs based on their condition and accessibility
- Instruct a competent, licensed contractor to remove ACMs which are in poor condition, easily accessible and thus readily disturbed, or that may be disturbed in the conduct of works
- Inform our Clients and assist if required to manage any ACMs left in place by labelling where there is a significant risk of disturbance, by regular inspection, and by setting up and maintaining procedures to prevent ACMs being disturbed inadvertently
- Provide information on the location and condition of ACMs to our Clients to allow them to distribute this information to anyone who is likely to disturb them
- Review the effectiveness of the Asbestos Management Policy and Asbestos Management Plan (if implemented) on a regular basis
- Promote awareness of the hazards of exposure to asbestos and the Companies Policy and Procedures through training of relevant staff
- Provide to relevant parties access to the Asbestos Register upon reasonable request

Policy Statement

The Company has put in place a management structure to ensure the asbestos management policy objectives are met. This includes the allocation of responsibility for asbestos management to the General Manager.
